Al was a baseball and basketball stand-out at Park and went on to play baseball at Hamline University where he played every inning of every game for four years. His Hamline team won the MIAC Championship in 1962. Al was an original member of the Park Hall of Fame Committee and is involved in the South Washington County Scholarship committee, which originally raised money for lights at the Oltman field and is still giving away scholarship money to District 833 students today.

In 1966 Al started in the insurance business as an agent/owner. He merged with his father's agency in 1970 and continued Wilkie Agency to present day. Over the years he has served on boards of directors for many organizations including Ronald McDonald House, St. Paul Jaycees, Girl Scout Council, Cottage Grove Chamber of Commerce and South Washington County Education Foundation.
