Ashley was a three-sport standout for Park earning All-Conference honors in volleyball, basketball, and softball. She was an All-State volleyball player who was an all-time career leader in kills with over 800. In fact, she tied the school record twice with 32 kills in a game; both of these games were against Woodbury. She led the team to back-to-back conference championships in 2000 and 2001. As a basketball player, Ashley earned All-Conference honors 3 times and was the first girl to score 1000 career points for Park. In softball, Ashley helped lead the team to the state championship game where they earn a 2nd place finish.

Ashley went on to play basketball at Concordia University where she helped lead the team to a 108-32 record over 4 years. The team made two appearances in the NCAA Division II Final Four. During her career, Ashley scored 1389 points while playing in 124 games which is tied for 4th highest in Concordia's all-time rankings. She still holds the record for number of field goals made in a game at 14 and is ranked 3rd all-time for points in a game at 33. In 2006, Ashley earned 3rd Team All-NSIC honors.

Ashley lives in Maplewood and has been a Financial & Cost Analyst at Norcraft Companies for the past 5 years.
