Jummy (Alowonle) Barlass was an active student-athlete who participated in three sports at Park High School including track and field, soccer and basketball. As a track and field standout at Park, Jummy won multiple conference and section championships, was a two-time state champion in the long jump, a state champion and runner-up in the triple jump and earned All-State honors a total of twelve times including four times in the 200 meter dash and three times in the 4x200. Jummy currently holds the Park High School records for both the long and triple jumps.

Jummy went on to compete in track and field at Iowa State University where she placed 3rd in the long jump at the 2004 NCAA qualifier. Jummy is currently the head girls track and field and jumps coach at Eden Prairie High School. She and her husband, Jake Barlass, live in Prior Lake with their three children Joshua, Jackson and James and are expecting number four.
