## **MCA Information:**

MCAs Thursday, April 29: Grade 10 Reading, Grade 11 Math.

There is no make-up date. Parents should call the attendance line to report students absent if they will not be present; testing is not mandatory this year.

Students should check their email for all of the details.

- Report to test room by 8:45 AM.
- Remain in room until 11:15 AM.
- All students finished with testing are dismissed at 11:15 AM.
- Testing takes 2.5 hours on average, so plan a ride if necessary.
- Buses via regular routes depart at usual times.
- Lunch available from 11:15 AM to 11:45 AM.
- Bring your fully charged iPad.
- Bring wired headphones for text-to-speech option on MCAs. A limited number of school-provided headphones are available.
- Bring a book to read in case you finish early.
- You are not permitted access to your phone during testing.
- Students continuing testing may do so after lunch and until 1:30 PM.

***Grades 9 & 12 will be asynchronous with distance learning on test day.***

Algebra 1 and geometry: TI-30XIIS (a scientific calculator)

If you are considering purchasing a graphing calculator: Texas Instrument 83 and 84 series: (these will take students through their college math and science courses)

TI-83, TI-83+, TI-83 silver

TI-84, TI-84+, TI-84 silver

TI-84 + C Silver - has a colored screen

TI-84CE - has a colored screen and rechargeable batteries
